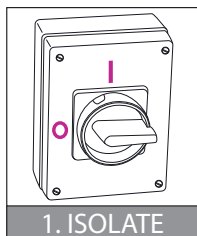

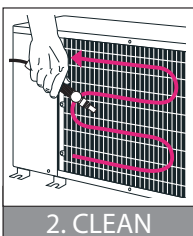

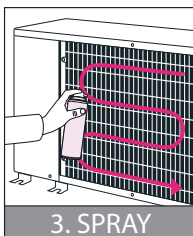
Directions of use



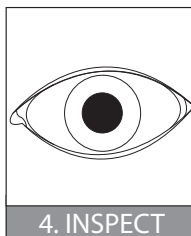
1. ISOLATE



2. CLEAN



3. SPRAY



4. INSPECT

Turn system off. Isolate electrics. Clean coil to remove all contamination and grease – even if coil is new. Ensure coil is dry before proceeding. Spray EasyCoat™ into coil, starting at top, then work methodically down and across. Wherever possible, treat both faces. EasyCoat™ contains a faint dye that allows easy verification of coating.

At each maintenance visit check coating is still intact. Reapply as required. If, due to multiple reapplication, the coating is decreasing heat transfer, request Advanced EasyCoat™ Cleaner to remove all EasyCoat™ – then start again.
